Membership Benefits

Monthly Meetings - Meetings are held on the fourth Thursday of each month January through October. The November and December meetings are combined and we meet on the first Thursday of December. The program starts at 6:30 pm. Come and check out the workshops that will be coming up or shop the vendor starting around 6:00. Q.U.I.L.T. meets at St. Thomas Episcopal Church at 2898 S. 48th St. in Springdale except for May. Check our programs page for the alternate locations for these meetings.

Programs - Well known speakers, as well as the Guild's own talented members, present a variety of stimulating programs relating to quilting. There may be an additional charge for non-members when we have a National speaker.

Workshops - Accomplished quilting teachers present workshops for members throughout the year at a reasonable cost.

Super Saturdays - Local guild members teach workshops approximately four times a year.

Quilt Show - Biennial Spring Quilt Show with opportunities for all members to participate,

Name Tags - Kits are given to new members to make their name tag, which are worn each month at regular meetings and special events. New kits can be purchased for \$5.00.

Monthly Newsletter - Includes notices of meetings, workshops, vendors, other activities and much more.

Yearly Dues - are \$25. We begin a business year in January and dues are prorated at \$15 starting in July. Junior memberships are \$10 for members age 18 and under. Dues for members age 80+ are complimentary. (**Membership chair must be notified of complimentary memberships**).
